John J. Wright Museum

Located within a historic landmark of Spotsylvania history- the John J Wright Educational and Cultural Center, formerly the John J Wright Consolidated School- on Courthouse Road is the only museum to honor the county’s African American education.

There you will find a permanent exhibit about the history of African American Education in Spotsylvania. The school’s history is told through the leadership of its 15 principals: from John J Wright in the early 1920s; to the longest serving principal, Alexander L. Scott; to the last serving African American principal, Pitman C. Rock, in the 1967-68 school year; and the school’s closure as a traditional middle school in 2006 under principal Chester Mummau. Regularly changing temporary exhibits show different aspects of Spotsylvania life. The museum, in the former Sadie Combs Johnson Library, is open 10:00 am to 3:00 pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

It is governed by a Board of Directors and supported by memberships, donations and fundraisers. Come and see what’s new; share your story. Donate or lend your memorabilia to help preserve our heritage. Our website: www.jjwmuseum.org. Support the museum with your visits, memberships and donations.
